



# Chardon Township Board of Trustees SPECIAL Meeting March 16, 2022

The Chardon Township Board of Trustees met in a special session on Wednesday, March 16, 2022 at 5:32 p.m. at the Town Hall with the following present:

Chardon Township met in special session with Concord Township to discuss road improvements on shared roads and to sign the 2022 Road Maintenance Agreement.

The following 2022 Road Maintenance Agreement between the two entities was signed:

## **CHARDON TOWNSHIP and CONCORD TOWNSHIP 2022 ROAD MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT**

The goal of this agreement is to establish a framework that outlines the responsibilities of each township as it relates to our jointly-owned roads: Colburn and Little Mountain. This agreement will also provide a path for future Boards and is designed to serve our residents.

### **COLBURN ROAD**

- Patching, filling potholes, and general repairs:

Ravenna Road to Timberlane: Chardon Township

Timberlane to Auburn: Concord Township

- Snow Plowing will be performed by: Concord Township
- For ditching and mowing Colburn Road, the responsibilities will be split as follows:

South side: Chardon Township

North side: Concord Township

### **LITTLE MOUNTAIN ROAD**

- Patching, filling potholes and general repairs will be performed by Chardon Township.
- Snow plowing will be performed by: Chardon Township
- For ditching and mowing, the responsibilities will be split as follows:

South side: Chardon Township

North side: Concord Township

Discussion ensued over various other road projects.

Trustee Brown made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 5:50 pm. Trustee Strazinsky seconded
