CERTIFICATE OF NEED

The Board of Trustees of Chardon Township, Geauga County, Ohio met in Special session on November 18, 2023, at Chardon Township Town Hall with the following trustees present:

Charles Strazinsky, Jr.

Michael Brown

Trustee Strazinsky moved the adoption of the following Resolution:

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of Chardon Township, Geauga County, Ohio has determined the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten-mill limitation by levies on the current tax duplicate will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of Chardon Township and it is necessary to levy a tax in excess of such limitation for the purpose of:

For the general construction, reconstruction, resurfacing and repair of streets, roads, and bridges in municipal corporations, counties, or townships;

In Chardon Township as provided and authorized in Ohio Revised Code §5705.19(G); and

WHEREAS the levy is at a rate of 3 mills for each one dollar of taxable value, for a period of 5 years and is additional; and

WHEREAS the ballot measure shall be submitted to the entire territory and the tax shall be levied on the entire territory and within Geauga County;

WHEREAS, the levy is to be placed on the ballot at the election held on March 5, 2024, and shall first be levied in tax year 2024 and begin collection in 2025.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Trustees of Chardon Township, Geauga County, Ohio, that based on the foregoing and pursuant to R.C. 5705.03(B), said board hereby certifies this Resolution to the Geauga County Auditor, and requests that the County Auditor certify back to

the Board of Trustees the amounts described in R.C. 5705.03(B)(2) that would be generated by the levy proposed herein.


Trustee Brown seconded the Motion, and the roll being called upon its adoption resulted as follows: **AYES: STRAZINSKY and BROWN**

- A resident asked if the township was going to do anything different this time to help the levy pass. The trustees said that they will do a newsletter, broadcast information on GTV and do information meetings at different times.
- The trustees told the residents that it is costing the township money to keep patching the roads. Discussion ensued about the need for the road levy.

Trustee Strazinsky made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 9:34 a.m. Trustee Brown seconded.
